

ExCom Report from March 2015 to August 2015

25th March

CNPF (Civil Nuclear Police Federation) Reception in the House of Commons, London. Angels Bosch participated.

30th March – 1st April

AGSI annual conference. Milan Stepanek participated.

30th March – 2nd April

Scottish Police Federation annual conference. Roger Mercatoris participated.

14th April

Hearing on Terrorism in Brussels. The President addressed the LIBE Committee in the Parliament. More information in the political report.

18th April

Celebration of NOSP, the Czech Police Union in Prague. The President participated and congratulated NOSP at a magnificent Ball in the Zofin palace in Prague.

21st April

Conference in Villnius regarding the future of policing in Lithuania arranged by NPPSS and the Lithuanian Police. The President participated with a speech and in a panel debate. The President also received a medal of honour from the Lithuanian Interior minister, Saulius Skvernelis, for the contribution of international cooperation.

13th May

Extra meeting with the Executive Committee in Berlin. Preparation of Congress was the main topic on the agenda.

19-20th May

PFEW (Police Federation of England and Wales) Conference in Bournemouth. The President addressed the Conference with a speech on how EuroCOP is trying to meet the austerity in Europe and what challenges we face.

21-22nd May
